How it works



Step 1 – Registration

- Volunteer organising committee, 2 from each club.
- Complete online registration form during summer before TY September start

Step 2 – Preparation

- Parents get added to WhatsApp group
- WhatsApp messages with details will be sent in advance of upcoming courses
- Decide what activities to do

Step 3 - Booking

- Links for sign up to courses will be sent via WhatsApp 3 / 4 weeks in advance of the course starting
- Places are first come first served. Extra courses to meet demand if required
- There is no joining fee for the programme. Students only pay for the activities they do.
