

# The National Yacht Club Junior Regatta 2024

## **Notice of Race**

- 1. The series will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 2. The Organising Authority is the National Yacht Club
- 3. Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to the following classes:

Main Fleet – Optimist, Topper 5.3, PY (inc.420s, 29er, Wayfarers, RS Ventures, RS200...), RS Feva, ILCA4 and ILCA6.

Harbour Fleet – Optimists, PY (inc. Topper 4.2, Topper 5.3, RS Terra, Pico, Topaz...)

Boats may enter to race in either the Main Fleet or the Harbour Fleet. IS Start Sailing, Basic Skills and First Year Improving Skills Competitors should enter the Harbour Fleet.

Competitors must be under 19 years of age on the 31st December 2024.

A new fleet is introduced in 2024: the 'inter-generation fleet' is composed of an adult and a child which must be under 13 years of age on the 31st of december 2024. To be eligible for a prize in that fleet, the child must helm. The new group will be sailed in the main fleet as part of the PY fleet..

Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form on the National Yacht Club website - www.nyc.ie

Registration will take place on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> 17:00 to 18:30 and on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> 08:15 to 09:00 at the NYC Race Office. Competitors briefing 09:15 on July 10<sup>th</sup>

### 4. Entry Fees

Single handed classes €20, Double handed classes €30. This fee includes Teddie's Ice Cream and BBQ.

#### 5. Schedule

Launching for both fleets is scheduled to commence at 10:00hrs with the first warning signal for the Harbour Fleet at 10:45 and the Main Fleet at 11:15. 3 races are scheduled.

Sailors should bring lunch and drinks afloat.

The food is scheduled to commence at 15:00 in the National Yacht Club, followed by outdoor prize giving.

#### 6. Venue and Courses

There shall be 2 courses. The course for the Main Fleet will, subject to weather, be located in the Seapoint Bay/ Scotsman Bay area of Dublin Bay. Course to be sailed shall be a Trapezoid Course. The course for the Harbour Fleet will be in Dun Laoghaire Harbour. Course to be sailed shall be a Triangular Course.
