



NYC Pontoon Berthing Policy

Members are reminded that berthing overnight on the NYC Pontoon is governed by our Breakwater Permit.

Permission to berth overnight must be sought from the Boathouse, with the Head Boatman or Senior Boatman on Duty.

The following list aims to cover all cases where mooring OVERNIGHT along the breakwater may be allowed:

1. Boats on moorings who want an early departure before normal launch service begins.
2. Boats on moorings that arrive back after normal launch service ends.
3. Boats on moorings or marina that are loading supplies or equipment.
4. Boats on moorings or marina that are carrying out repairs that require the facilities of the pontoon, or have an early morning boathouse service booked.
5. Boats on moorings that are temporarily unseaworthy and cannot be left on the moorings.
6. Boats that are being used as Committee Boats for events.
7. Visiting boats that are HYC Associate or overseas members of the Club.



8. Special visitors who have been invited by the Club or who are taking part in races run by the Club e.g. ISORA boats, Cruising Company etc.
9. Boats on moorings or marina that due to “circumstances” (primarily weather) are unable to return the boats to their mooring.

It is not acceptable that boats that race on Thursday evening to remain on the pontoon until Saturday.

Your co-operation is expected and appreciated.

A fee of €50.00 will occur in the event of the boat needing to be brought back to its mooring or marina berthing by the Boathouse Staff.

This policy was adopted by the NYC Management Committee on Monday 13th May 2024 and is effective immediately.
